



HURRICANE FLORENCE DISASTER RELIEF EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

NOW RECRUITING WORKSITES!

- Are you a public or private non-profit agency?
- Is your organization in need of help due to increased traffic and/or work due to Hurricane Florence?

The Disaster Relief Employment Program provides funding for programs to provide temporary jobs to citizens that reside in Brunswick, Columbus, New Hanover, and Pender counties. These jobs assist local recovery efforts through clean up and repair of facilities, and humanitarian assistance in the impacted counties.

These jobs are for individuals who are unemployed as a result of Hurricane Florence, individuals who have lost their jobs due to a closure or layoff, and individuals who have been unemployed for 12 weeks. Those participating in the program will be paid the prevailing rate of pay for other individuals employed in a similar occupation within your agency. Individuals can work a maximum of 12 months or 2,080 hours.
